Submission instructions

The submitted manuscripts will follow the SHL Journal's guidelines for Original Research Articles. These are full-length submissions related to the aims & scope of the journal, which naturally relate to the NSSHL conference. Articles should be 6,000–8,000 words, including tables, figure captions, and references. Manuscripts outside the recommended length will be accepted at the discretion of the editors. Authors will submit papers as instructed on the SHL Journal site. All authors need to subscribe to the journal [HERE](#) to submit a manuscript.

Review process

All submissions will first be screened by the guest editors and editor in chief and, if found to be appropriate to the special issue, will undergo peer review by at least two anonymous reviewers. The journal operates using a double-blind review process, meaning that authors and reviewers will remain anonymous to one another. Based on the reviewers' reports, the editor will determine whether to reject, or accept (with minor or major revisions) the manuscript.
